Tips on presenting a 5minute ePoster Presentation





Start with a Strong Introduction



Begin with a brief introduction that includes the title of your ePoster and a quick overview of what you will cover.





Focus on Key Points



Identify the most important points or findings in your ePoster.

Avoid covering everything; prioritize data or insights that are most impactful or interesting.





Use an Engaging Visual Aid



Utilize your ePoster as a visual aid.

Point out specific charts, graphs, or images as you discuss them.





Practice Concise Explanation



Practice explaining your points succinctly.

Aim to convey each key point in less than a minute.





5 Tell a Story



Frame your presentation as a narrative.

This makes it more engaging and easier for the audience to follow.






Anticipate Questions



Prepare for potential questions.

Think about what aspects of your research might intrigue or confuse the audience.





Rehearse Timings



Practice your presentation multiple times to ensure you can comfortably fit it within 5 minutes.

Use a timer during rehearsals.





Speak Clearly and Confidently



Speak at a steady pace, clearly and with confidence.

Avoid rushing through your presentation.






9 Prepare for Technical Issues



Be prepared for any technical hiccups, especially if presenting virtually.





End with a Conclusion or Takeaway



Conclude with a brief summary or a key takeaway from your research.

Leave the audience with something memorable.
